Re: Colony Pump Station Abandonment Project SS#5003

Dear Owners/Residents:

The Northwestern Water & Sewer District ("District") will be replacing an aged sanitary sewer system in your area. Additionally, a sanitary sewer pump station will be abandoned. The majority of the project will be concentrated in the areas of Elm Tree and Colony Roads. This project is part of an on-going effort by the District to eliminate sanitary sewer overflows (SSO) into local streams and rivers and improve the overall system quality in the area.

This sewer main will be installed within the public road right-of-way. Unfortunately, some landscaping, trees, bushes, fencing, invisible fencing and underground sprinkler systems will need to be removed in an effort to avoid existing utilities and potential customer outages. **These items may not be replaced by the contractor.** Right-of-way areas will be graded and seeded upon project completion.

The contractor, HPH Mechanical will be performing the construction on behalf of the District. This project is scheduled to begin in late August and continue until late spring of 2016. We expect the restoration work and paving to be completed in the late spring of 2016.

Road closures and detours can also be expected as a part of this project; however, local traffic access will be maintained. To make special arrangements to access your driveway due to work, school transportation, etc., please contact the number listed below.

The District will have an inspector on-site at all times to address any issues or concerns. However, if you have questions or need additional information, please call me at (419) 354-9090, ext. 175. The District will try to accommodate all requests and do everything it can to minimize any disturbance that this project may cause.
