Re: Park and Colony Road - Waterline Improvements

Dear Resident/Owner:

The Northwestern Water & Sewer District ("District") will be installing a waterline in your area. Construction will begin the week April 16, 2017 on Colony Road and Park Road and should be completed by May.

The waterline project will include the District's portion of your water service into the right-of-way with a new meter pit assembly. Once the new water main is completed, your service will be switched over to the new main. There will be minor service interruptions when this occurs. There may be periods of service interruption during construction as well, but we will make every attempt to notify you of this beforehand. The new waterline will be constructed within the right of way. Additionally, the new meter pit at the right of way will be installed with a backflow device. This may require you to install an expansion tank in your plumbing system. The new meter pits contain a double check valve. This is required by the Ohio EPA and may cause your water heater relief valve to activate at night. In order to remedy this, an expansion tank may need to be added to your hot water heater and you may want to contact your local plumber to do so. In preparing for this construction we will have all underground utilities located to avoid damaging them during the work. We request that you mark and locate any private underground facilities such as drainage fields, invisible fences or sprinkler systems. If you are not the property owner, please mark any facilities of which you are aware, and notify the property owner of this impending work. Damage to existing invisible fencing, sprinkler systems or the like, as a result of construction in the road right-of-way, will not be replaced.

The entire project is scheduled to begin in April 2017 and completed in May 2017.

Access to Park Drive from Colony will be blocked during the daylight working hours but will be open after daytime construction, this will occur for two to three days. During this time, local traffic to resident's homes will be maintained; however, some brief delays may occur during construction. Once work is completed the contractor will be restoring the area and planting grass. If you have any questions in the meantime, please call me (419) 354-9090 ext. #173
